

Dear Exhibitor: We are interested in your business or cause joining us in our Ralph Kolp Exhibit Hall during the Redwood County Fair! At the 2026 Redwood County Fair we saw an attendance of over 23,000! **Set-up is Thursday, July 15th 10am to 4pm. DO NOT SHOW UP EARLY TO SET UP.** The exhibits will be open Thursday 5-8pm; Friday and Saturday 10am to 8pm; and Sunday Noon to 4pm. The Fair will run Thursday July 15th through Sunday July 18th. We will only be accepting one vendor per category, to keep with the “no compete” policy. Please return your completed application with your ST19 Operator Certificate of Compliance ASAP to reserve your place. The fee per single exhibit booth is \$125 or \$200 for a double booth. There will be a mandatory “Early Teardown Deposit” of \$50 (refundable) which will not be cashed, but will be held until 4pm Sunday July 18th, at which time it will be returned to all exhibitors who are still manning their booths, as long as they setup their booth between 10am-4pm on Thursday. Please make checks payable to Redwood County Fair. There is limited space available so please make sure to get your fee and paperwork in as soon as you are sure you will be interested in renting a booth. Chairs & tables are not provided.

With your Exhibitor Fee you will also receive (1) Vendor Admission Wristband. Extra Admission wristbands are available for purchase in the fair office for \$25. YOUR BOOTH “WORKERS” ARE REQUIRED TO PAY A GATE FEE. Single day admission is \$12 before 6pm. There is NO free admission for any booth worker. There is NO free parking for any booth worker. If you or one of those working your booth require handicap parking, that is available through the south gate with verification on the vehicle.

When you arrive to setup at the fairgrounds, check in at the south gate, drive to the fair office where you will receive your wristband(s) and information packet, unload your items, and go park in the main parking lot, THEN return to setup your booth, so other vendors can unload their items. Fairground parking passes are available for purchase at an extra charge of \$50. **Your vehicle will be towed at your expense if you park in the fairgrounds throughout the fair without a parking pass.**

Daycare Day 10am-Noon: Friday of the fair is "Daycare Day". We invite all Daycares in Redwood County and surroundings counties to bring their kids to the fair. We are inviting the vendors to have things at their booth for the kids. This is not mandatory, but highly suggested to help promote your booth! If you decide to participate you would be asked to have a piece of candy, coloring sheet, or small item for approximately 350 kids, between the ages of 2-10. Make sure to have your business name/contact info printed on a label, attached to each piece of candy/item so that the parent's see what vendors we have in our building! This will intrigue parents to walk through our vendor booths when they bring their kids back out to the fair later on.

Restricted Items: No weapons may be sold from your booth. This includes swords, knives, and guns. Only one vendor may represent each booth. If you plan to sell more than one company's items, please reserve multiple booths. Do not sell items from your booth that you did not pre-register for. (ex. If you register with kid's toys, you are not allowed to sell items from Tupperware or a skincare line, etc.) We only allow one vendor for each company to register for a booth. Do not expand your booth past the booth space you a registered for. If you do so you may not be asked to come back for the next year's fair.

We will have fun characters on the fairgrounds throughout all fair week! Don't forget that with your booth fee you will have free admittance to watch all the bands perform. Please keep in mind that space is limited. Those who respond first and mail me their application with check first, will have their booth space reserved.
